Your young inventor was chosen to participate in the 22^{nd} statewide celebration to represent their school and celebrate inventors throughout the state and beyond. This event is a great way for students to display their inventions to the community and share their inventions and ideas with other inventors from across the state.

We invite you and your family to participate in the Fidelity Investments 2008 Young Inventors' Celebration on Saturday, April 5, 2008 from 8am to 2pm at Winnisquam Regional High School.

9:00 – 11:15	General Viewing & Judging of Inventions The public is invited to visit the classrooms and the gym to meet the inventors and their inventions.
10:00 - 11:30	Mr. Phil Comedic Magician (Cafeteria)
11:00 - 11:45	Lunch (Cafeteria)
Noon	Awards Ceremony (Gymnasium)

What to Expect...

Please enter the event through the auditorium/gymnasium entrance (to the right of the front entrance).

Registration begins at 8:00 - Registration tables for *inventions* will be set up as you enter the building. If your young inventor has a **Rube Goldberg**[®] Machine proceed to the right toward the gym – Registration and set-up for Rube Goldberg[®] Machines will be held in the gym.

Inventions and Rube Goldberg® Machines may be grouped in grade ranges depending on the number of entries and given a room assignment at registration. Once registered, please go to the assigned room and help to arrange the desks in a horseshoe pattern and set up the invention. This makes judging easier. If time permits, please join us for complimentary refreshments in the cafeteria.

Judging Timeline...

All inventors with a **RED** nametag should be with their inventions in the assigned room at **9:00** and remain there until the judging ends at **9:45**.

All inventors with a **GREEN** nametag should be with their inventions in the assigned room at **9:45** and remain there until the judging ends at **10:30**.

All inventors with a **BLUE** nametag should be with their inventions in the assigned room at **10:30** and remain there until the judging ends at **11:15**.

When packing up inventions to go home, your help in putting the room back the way it was would be greatly appreciated. It would be helpful if the inventions are taken to your car before the award ceremony begins.

- Student inventors should remain in the judging room for the entire judging period.
- The presentation of the invention should not exceed 3 minutes.
- We ask that parents (and others) step out of the room (or aside in the gym) while the inventions are being judged (45 minutes).

What to Bring on Saturday, April 5th....

Each student should bring their invention or Rube Goldberg® Machine.

Student Entry Form/Invention Log - The Student Entry Form (given to the student inventor at his/her school) should be brought to the event and displayed with the student's invention. Each student should be prepared to talk about their invention and display their entry form and invention log (3 minute time limit.)

Authorization Form - Please bring the authorization form (enclosed) to the event and drop off at the registration table or fax 603-228-4730. The authorization form authorizes the Academy of Applied Science to display photos, names, etc. on promotional material and the Academy's website.

Directions to Winnisquam Regional High School...

<u>193 South</u> - Take Exit 20 (Tilton). Turn RIGHT onto Route 3 (South). Approximately 3 miles to center of Tilton continue straight through set of lights. Approximately 1 mile on the RIGHT is the high school entrance.

<u>I93 North</u> - Take Exit 19. At end of ramp turn LEFT. Approximately 1½ miles to center of Tilton, at set of lights turn LEFT. Approximately 1mile on the RIGHT is the high school entrance.
